CP chair asks BSU
S&QA to write to

Case discussion between the CP Chair and IRO as to whether the CP Plan should continue or not.

IRO is allocated and they contact the SW to arrange a Looked After Review (has to check the date of the next RCPC so only 1 meeting is held).

## The Social Worker

- (i) Informs the CP Chair
- (ii) Contacts S&QA to request an IRO for the CLA reviews
- (iii) Informs the professional network that the child/ren are now Looked After
- (iv) Starts completing the report for the 1st CLA review

Children subject to CP become Looked After

## First Looked After Child Review

If the decision has been agreed to end the CP Plan the IRO endorses the decision in the review. Any outstanding recommendations are incorporated into the child's Care Plan and the CLA process now manages and reviews this.

After the review the IRO informs the BSU that the CP Plan has ended so BSU can update ICS and inform professionals
