

Child becomes LAC and subject to Interim Care Order



Line manager for the lead social worker informs the allocated CP Coordinator that the child is now looked after and seeks consultation as to whether the CP plan should now end. This is followed up in writing by the lead social worker in the form of a simple conference report (ICS).



The CP Coordinator has a discussion with the IRO to ensure all the risks identified in the CP Plan have been reduced. An agreement is reached about proposing to remove the CP Plan.



CP Coordinator makes a recommendation to Operational Manager for Safeguarding and Quality to end the child protection plan.



Operational Manager for Safeguarding and Quality Assurance writes to all members of the last child protection conference informing them of the proposal to end the child protection plan.



If no dissent is received, the child protection plan is removed without reconvening a child protection conference.



CP Coordinator writes up the reason for deciding to end the child protection plan, which is then placed in the 'Record of a Child Protection Conference' on ICS.



1st LAC review confirms that the child protection plan has ended and ensures that any outstanding actions from the CP plan are incorporated in the child's care plan.
